5	30:14-13.1	Provides that information about the location of a shelter for victims of domestic violence shall not be a public record
8	39:4-50 39:4-50.2a 39:4-50.4a	Clarifies sentencing provisions for certain drunk driving offenses; requires Attorney General to promulgate guidelines concerning prosecution of DWI violations; guidelines must be disseminated to county and municipal prosecutors within 120 days of the effective date of the act (4/26/04).
10	2A:154-5	Empowers United States Department of Defense police to make arrests for certain violations of New Jersey law.
11	2C:20-1	Expands the definition of access device to include ATM bank cards.
16	56:8-136 through 58:8-152	“Contractors’ Registration Act” imposes certain obligations on home improvement contractors; section 11 (C.56:8-146) makes a knowing violation of any provision of the act a fourth-degree crime.
69	39:4-97.2	Establishes a Merit Rating Plan surcharge for unsafe driving.

144	2C:21-21	Amends "New Jersey Anti-Piracy Act" to include camcorder piracy of motion pictures.
149	40A:9-117.2	Authorizes appointment of unpaid deputy sheriffs in certain counties.
150	2C:64-1 56:3-13.16 56:3-13.22	Revises counterfeit goods and forfeiture laws to deter criminal street gang activities.
151	2C:7-13	Clarifies certain exception from publication on sex offender Internet registry.
185	2B:25-5.1	Requires municipal prosecutors to review and transmit to judge, prior to sentencing, motor vehicle abstracts of persons charged with a violation of R.S.39:3-40 or R.S.39:4-129.
