between on or about November 1, 2000, and on or about August 31, 2003, in the Township of Hainesport, in the County of Burlington, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, being a public servant, that is, the Township of Hainesport Mayor and Director of Public Works, and acting with purpose to obtain a benefit for himself and others, did commit acts relating to his office but constituting an unauthorized exercise of his official functions, knowing that such acts were committed in an unauthorized manner, that is, the said RONALD F. CORN, SR., knowingly did divert Township of Hainesport funds to his own personal use and the use of others, contrary to provision of N.J.S.A. 2C:30-2 and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.
