The Grand Jurors of and for the State of New Jersey, upon their oaths, present that:

COUNT ONE

(Theft by Deception-Third Degree)

CLIFTON E. BOONE

between on or about January 16, 1999 through February 27, 1999, at the Borough of Lindenwold, in the County of Camden, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, purposely did obtain by deception the property of the State of New Jersey, valued in excess of \$500; that is, the said Clifton E. Boone did purposely obtain unemployment insurance benefits in the amount of \$2,442 by submitting or causing to be submitted documents for unemployment insurance benefits of the State of New Jersey, thereby creating or reinforcing false impressions to the State of New Jersey that the said CLIFTON E. BOONE was unemployed;

WHEREAS IN TRUTH AND IN FACT, as the said CLIFTON E. BOONE then and there well knew, he was employed, all contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:20-4, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT TWO

(Theft by Deception-Third Degree)

CLIFTON E. BOONE

between on or about January 22, 2000 through July 1, 2000, at the Borough of Lindenwold, in the County of Camden, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, purposely did obtain by deception the property of the State of New Jersey, valued in excess of \$500; that is, the said CLIFTON E. BOONE did purposely obtain unemployment insurance benefits in the amount of \$7,623 by submitting or causing to be submitted documents for unemployment insurance benefits of the State of New Jersey, thereby creating or reinforcing false impressions to the State of New Jersey that the said CLIFTON E. BOONE was unemployed;


WHEREAS IN TRUTH AND IN FACT, as the said CLIFTON E. BOONE then and there well knew, he was employed, all contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:20-4, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT THREE

(Unsworn Falsification to Authorities-Fourth Degree)


CLIFTON E. BOONE

on or about July 10, 2000 at the at the Borough of Lindenwold, and in the Township of Cherry Hill, both in the County of Camden, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly did make a written false statement which he did not believe to be true on or pursuant to a form bearing notice, authorized by law, to the effect that false statements made therein are punishable; that is, the said CLIFTON E. BOONE did make and submit or cause to be submitted Unemployment Insurance Benefit check number 22059142 dated July 3, 2000, containing a false statement that the said CLIFTON E. BOONE did report all holiday or vacation pay and otherwise met all eligibility requirements to receive unemployment insurance benefits for the weeks ending June 24 and July 1, 2000, respectively, and said form bearing notice, authorized by law, to the effect that false statements made therein are punishable, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:28-3a, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.
