

INDICTMENT

The Grand Jurors of and for the State of New Jersey, upon their oaths, present that:

COUNT ONE

(Theft by Deception-Third Degree)

CHRISTINA A. SCOTT

between on or about September 25, 1999 through January 29, 2000, at the Township of Willingboro, in the County of Burlington, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, purposely did obtain by deception the property of the State of New Jersey, valued in excess of \$500; that is, the said CHRISTINA A. SCOTT did purposely obtain unemployment insurance benefits in the amount of \$3,000 by submitting or causing to be submitted documents for unemployment insurance benefits to the State of New Jersey, thereby creating or reinforcing false impressions to the State of New Jersey that the said CHRISTINA A. SCOTT was

unemployed;

WHEREAS IN TRUTH AND IN FACT, as the said CHRISTINA A. SCOTT then and there well knew, she was employed, all contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:20-4, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT TWO

(Theft by Deception-Third Degree)

CHRISTINA A. SCOTT

between on or about September 30, 2000 through February 17, 2001, at the Township of Willingboro, in the County of Burlington, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, purposely did obtain by deception the property of the State of New Jersey, valued in excess of \$500; that is, the said CHRISTINA A. SCOTT did purposely obtain unemployment insurance benefits in the amount of \$4,095 by submitting or causing to be submitted documents for unemployment insurance benefits to the State of New Jersey, thereby creating or reinforcing false impressions to the State of New Jersey that the said CHRISTINA A. SCOTT was unemployed;

WHEREAS IN TRUTH AND IN FACT, as the said CHRISTINA A. SCOTT then and there well knew, she was employed, all contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:20-4, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.
