INDICTMENT

The Grand Jurors of and for the State of New Jersey, upon their oaths, present that:

COUNT ONE

(Theft by Deception-Third Degree)

RICHARD WIGGINS

between on or about March 24, 1999, and on or about May 6, 1999 at the Township of Dover, in the County of Ocean, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, purposely did obtain by deception the property of the State of New Jersey, valued in excess of \$500; that is, the said RICHARD WIGGINS did purposely obtain unemployment insurance benefits in the amount of \$3120.00 by submitting or causing to be submitted documents for unemployment insurance benefits of the State of New Jersey, thereby creating or reinforcing false impressions to the State of New Jersey that the said RICHARD WIGGINS was unemployed;

WHEREAS IN TRUTH AND IN FACT, as the said RICHARD WIGGINS then and there well knew, he was employed, all contrary to the

provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:20-4, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT TWO

(Theft by Deception-Third Degree)

RICHARD WIGGINS

between on or about March 2, 2000, and on or about April 22, 2000 at the Township of Dover, in the County of Ocean, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, purposely did obtain by deception the property of the State of New Jersey, valued in excess of \$500; that is, the said RICHARD WIGGINS did purposely obtain unemployment insurance benefits in the amount of \$5148.00 by submitting or causing to be submitted documents for unemployment insurance benefits of the State of New Jersey, thereby creating or reinforcing false impressions to the State of New Jersey that the said RICHARD WIGGINS was unemployed;

WHEREAS IN TRUTH AND IN FACT, as the said RICHARD WIGGINS then and there well knew, he was employed, all contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:20-4, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT THREE

(Theft by Deception-Third Degree)

RICHARD WIGGINS

between on or about March 16, 2001, and on or about April 27, 2001 at the Township of Dover, in the County of Ocean, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, purposely did obtain by deception the property of the State of New Jersey, valued in excess of \$500; that is, the said RICHARD WIGGINS did purposely obtain unemployment insurance benefits in the amount of \$3003.00 by submitting or causing to be submitted documents for unemployment insurance benefits of the State of New Jersey, thereby creating or reinforcing false impressions to the State of New Jersey that the said RICHARD WIGGINS was unemployed;

WHEREAS IN TRUTH AND IN FACT, as the said RICHARD WIGGINS then and there well knew, he was employed, all contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:20-4, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.
