The Grand Jurors of and for the State of New Jersey, upon their oaths, present that:

COUNT ONE

(Theft by Deception-Third Degree)

SHARRISE P. PIERCE

between on or about June 15, 1999 and on or about December 3, 1999, at the City of Elizabeth, in the County of Union, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, purposely did obtain by deception the property of the State of New Jersey, valued in excess of \$500; that is, the said SHARRISE P. PIERCE did purposely obtain unemployment insurance benefits in the amount of \$6,425 by submitting or causing to be submitted documents for unemployment insurance benefits of the State of New Jersey, thereby creating or reinforcing false impressions to the State of New Jersey that the said SHARRISE P. PIERCE was

unemployed;


WHEREAS IN TRUTH AND IN FACT, as the said SHARRISE P. PIERCE then and there well knew, she was employed, all contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:20-4, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT TWO


(Unsworn Falsification to Authorities-Fourth Degree)

SHARRISE P. PIERCE

on or about December 7, 1999 at the City of Elizabeth, in the County of Union, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly did make a written false statement which he did not believe to be true on or pursuant to a form bearing notice, authorized by law, to the effect that false statements made therein are punishable; that is, the said SHARRISE P. PIERCE did make and submit or cause to be submitted Unemployment Insurance Benefit check number 20430112 dated December 3, 1999, containing a false statement that the said SHARRISE P. PIERCE did report all holiday or vacation pay and otherwise met all eligibility requirements to receive unemployment insurance benefits for the week ending November 27, 1999, respectively, and said form bearing notice, authorized by law, to the effect that false statements made therein are punishable, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:28-3a, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.


